

Termo de Posse dos Vereadores, mandato 2013/2016.

Ao 1º (primeiro) dia do mês de janeiro de 2013 (dois mil e treze), às 9:00 (nove) horas, no Plenário Celso Vilela na Câmara Municipal de Anápolis, reuniu-se em Sessão Solene sob a Presidência do vereador Pedro Antonio Barreto de Oliveira, por ter sido o vereador mais votado no pleito de 2012 (dois mil e doze, obtendo 3.316 (três mil e trezentos e dezesseis) votos, secretariado por Afilton Batista de Faria Filho - 1º secretário, que obteve (2.965) votos, tendo a segunda maior votação, e Eli Rosa da Silva - 2º secretário, que obteve (2.745) votos, tendo a 3ª maior votação. Encontravam-se presentes também os vereadores: Valdair de Jesus Costa (2.717) votos, Jean Carlos Ribeiro (2.535) votos, Pedro Carneiro da Ponte (2.228) votos, Carlos Alberto Rodrigues (2.155) votos, Luiz Santos Macerda (2.096) votos, Fernando de Almeida Cunha (1.912) votos, Dinamélia Ribeiro de Oliveira Rabelo (1.894) votos, Wlederson Cristiano da Silva Lopes (1.875) votos, Jesus Fernandes Abreu (1.763) votos, Paulo Roberto de Castro Lima (1.724) votos, Despasiano dos Reis Gomes (1.717) votos, Miruan Garcia Sampaio Pimenta (1.680) votos, Jackson Charles Oliveira (1.656) votos, Eder Batista Marade (1.599) votos, Mauro José Severiano (1.589) votos, Wilmar José Silvestre (1.430) votos, Cleimor Martins dos Anjos (1.357) votos, Lusley José Borges (1.323) votos, João Pereira de Souza (1.267) votos e Flávia Geli Sanchez - (1.160) votos. Depois de feita a chamada

dos senhores vereadores presentes, o Presidente deu por iniciada a Sessão Solene, visando empossar os senhores vereadores que foram eleitos no dia 07/10/2012 (sete de outubro de dois mil e doze). O Presidente convidou a todos os presentes para que de pé curassem o Hino Nacional Brasileiro. Depois de terem feito a apresentação dos documentos que atestam suas condições de vereadores eleitos. O Presidente convidou os senhores vereadores para que ficassem de pé, com o braço direito estendido e convidou o vereador Eber Batista Mamude para conduzir a leitura do Termo de Compromisso de acordo com que reza o artigo 3º, parágrafo 1º do Regimento Interno, lendo: "Prometo manter, defender e cumprir a Constituição Federal, a Constituição Estadual; observar as Leis, particularmente a Lei Orgânica do município de Anápolis; promover o bem coletivo e exercer com patriotismo, honestidade e Espírito Público o mandato que me foi conferido". Ao final da leitura os vereadores repetiram: Assim eu Prometo. Concluídas as formalidades, o Presidente, Pedro Antônio Mariano de Oliveira, usando das atribuições conferidas pelo Regimento Interno, Lei Orgânica, das Constituições Federais e Estadual, declarou empossados os mesmos como vereadores deste município de Anápolis para o quadriênio 2013/2016 (dois mil e treze a dois mil e dezesseis). A Sessão deu prosseguimento com a eleição da mesa diretora da Câmara Municipal para o biênio 2013/2014 (dois mil e treze a dois mil e quatorze). E, para constar, eu

Mariza Carneiro de Medeiros, laurei este Cermo de Posse, que vai assinado pelos vereadores empossados e pela Mesa Diretora.
